Hamplus which is a piece of equipment that allows us to bring all our antennas to one junction and easily select which radio(s) you would like to connect to each antenna. When the radios are not in use, they are automatically disconnected, and the antennas are all sent to ground. Currently, members use radio equipment and sometimes do not properly disconnect antennas from equipment before leaving. Getting an antenna selector such as Hamplus would provide convenience to radio operators and most importantly, protect club equipment. The only distributor in the US is DX Engineering, and they will be sending informational brochures to the club.

Marcel has been in contact with DX Engineering regarding the antenna switch (Hamplus) has emailed them three times, called them requesting info and pricing, they said they would send info Marcel hasn't seen anything yet. Marcel will call them again to see what is going on.
