We hear that K101C is now certified to work on NASA equipment.

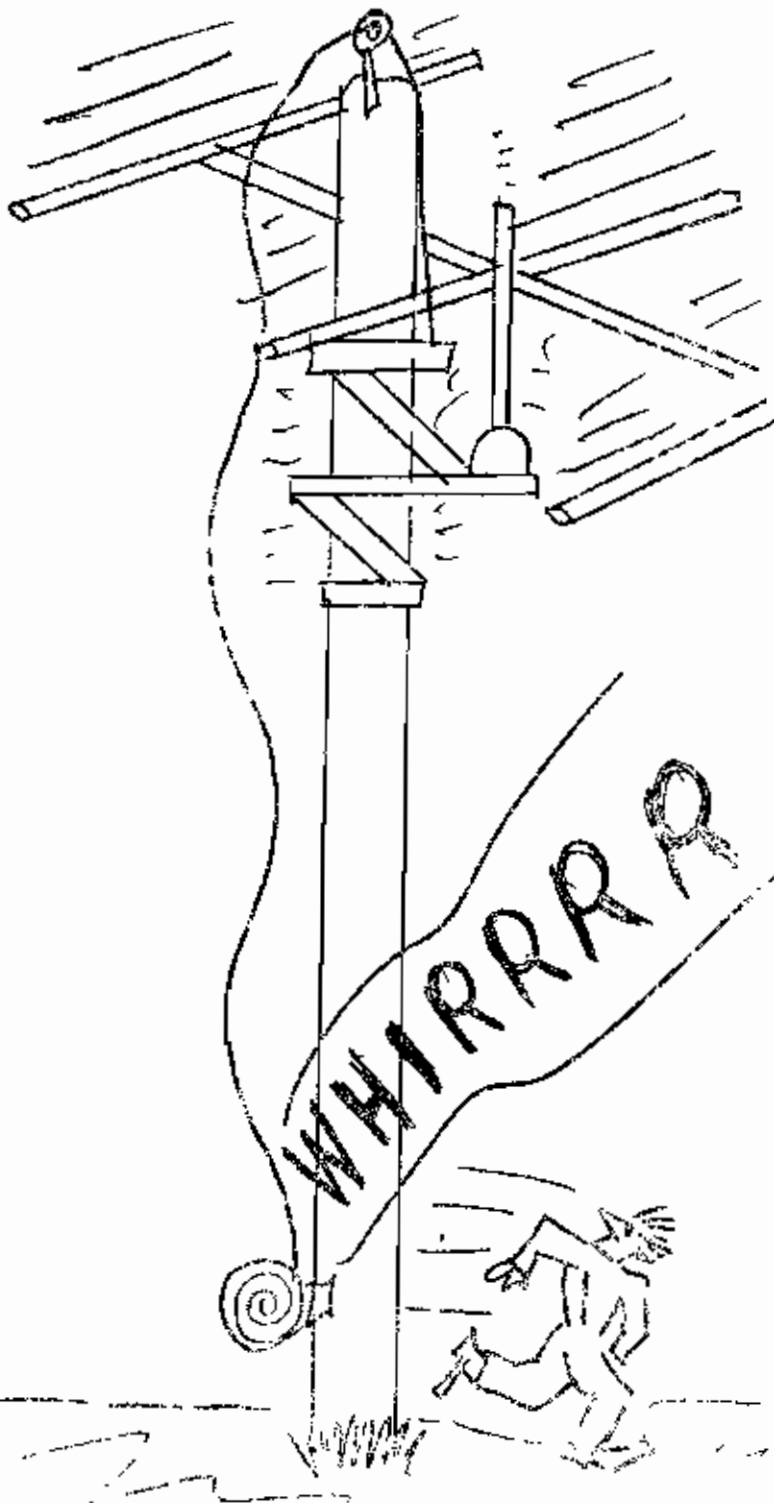
Since WA100M left his old job with the city and has started working for Raytheon in R.I. We now see him riding around in a 63 chevy, this must mean something but we really don't know what.

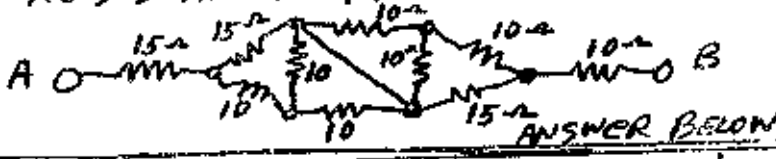

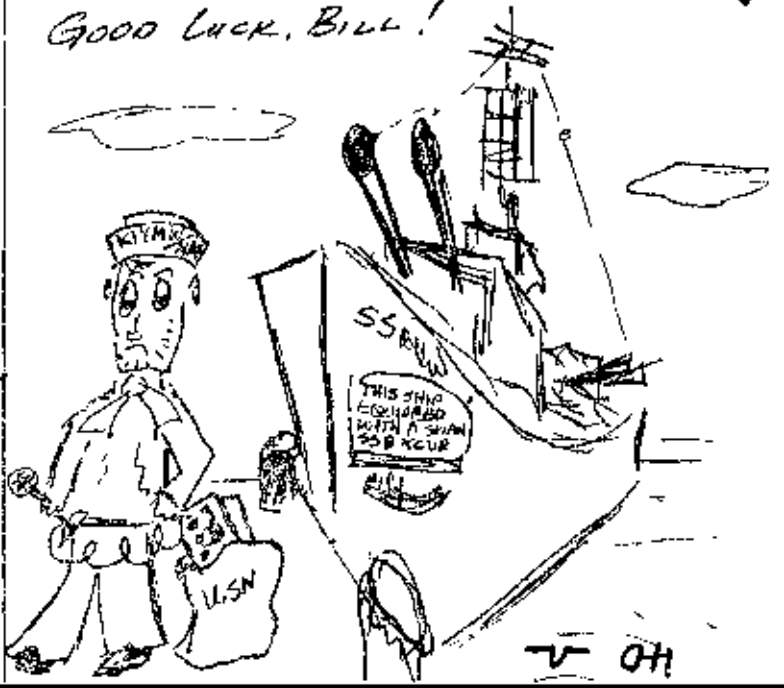
