## Pause between transmissions.

Should you wish to join an existing OSO, simply announce your call letters during the pause. This will allow the current conversation to continue while making all concerned aware of your presence on the air.

of you're pressed for time: you need a phone-patch, or must contact another station, or you're giving traffic assistance; announce BREAK. The current conversation showed cease and the "breaker" be immediately acknowledged.

't you're dealing with a real emergency: announce BREAK, BREAK. All current transmissions MUST...repeat, MUST cease to allow the "breaker" to take over.

Please, your cooperation is needed and will be deeply appreciated by each and every one of us.

One further note--rumor has it that a solid state repeater is close at hand!!!

Therefore, after you've called the NEWS LINE how about dropping off the information at the club...might help us make this a better paper.




