Scholarship Application Instructions

1. The SEMARA Scholarship is available to students living in Southeastern Massachusetts. Our objective is to promote amateur radio to young persons and the radio hobby in general.
2. This page is not a part of the application and need not be submitted.
3. The application and transcript **MUST** be postmarked during the application filing window of January 1 to March 1. There are no exceptions.
4. Scholarships are awarded for the following academic year
5. A signed original application, a 600-word essay about amateur radio, and paper copies of all transcripts are required. *E-mail submissions will not be accepted.*
6. Letters of reference must be attached to the application.
7. If the space provided for your response is not large enough, you may write “*see attached*” on the application and include an enclosure or resume. Be sure any enclosure or resume includes your full name. Mark clearly the portion of the application referenced.
8. Use only one side of the application form. Please do not write on the reverse side. Attach additional sheets as necessary.

1. How is amateur radio used in a disaster?
2. How is amateur radio used in communications?
3. How is amateur radio used in satellite communications?
4. How do we experiment with amateur radio?
5. How does amateur radio help with local event communications?
6. How does amateur radio interface with computers?
