Scholarship Instructions

1. The SEMARA Scholarship is available to high school students living in Southeastern Massachusetts. Our objective is to promote amateur radio to young persons and the radio hobby in general.
2. This page is not a part of the application and need not be submitted.
3. The application and transcript **MUST** be postmarked during the application filing window of January 1 to March 1. There are no exceptions.
4. Scholarships are awarded for the current academic year.
5. A signed original application, a 600-word essay about amateur radio, and paper copies of all transcripts are required. Email submissions will not be accepted.
6. Letters of reference must be attached by applicant.
7. If the space provided for your response is not large enough, you may write "see attached" on the application and include an enclosure or resume. Be sure the enclosure or resume is clearly marked as to the question each portion applies and includes your full name.
8. Use only one side of the application form. Please do not write on the reverse side. Attach additional sheets as necessary.
